- the long-term consequences of the proposed Enerdu dam in Mississippi Mills, erosion of river banks, deterioration of spawning beds, loss of loon and duck nests habitat, deforestation, elevated water levels of Appleton Wetlands killing off the trees, loss of tourism, loss of recreational use of the river, dangers to downriver and upriver residents resulting from water levels fluctuation 1.5 m. up and down (unprecedented)
- end of era of a run-of-the-river free-flowing river to one in which the water is stored and released at peak earning times, releasing large amounts of water suddenly. Storage of water above the dam will also raise water levels as far upstream as Appleton
